

**Arrowhead at Vail Design Review Committee  
Tent Guidelines**

Adopted by the Arrowhead Design Review Committee on June 1, 2006.

The Design Review Committee may approve of temporary event tents for hosting special events deemed to be in the best interest of homeowners and resort guests based on the following criteria:

**General Guidelines**

**Tent Size:** 30'x 40' maximum (Broken Arrow Café 75' x 30' maximum). The DRC may allow tents of other sizes, to be reviewed on a case-by-case basis.

**Number of Allowable Tents:** No more than 1 tent will be permitted at any time on a subject property.

**Color:** All tents shall be white.

**Location:** Tents shall only be permitted to be installed in a location that: A.) Does not require removal or alteration of existing vegetation; B.) Will not cause damage to existing vegetation on the property; or C.) Will not cause negative visual impacts to adjacent properties within the resort.

**Maximum Length of Time:** Tents will be permitted May through October. No tent shall be permitted more than 3 days, including set-up and tear down. The DRC may allow tents at other times of the year, to be reviewed on a case-by-case basis.

**Generators:** Generators/compressors are prohibited.

**Parking:** Parking is subject to the Arrowhead Rules and Regulations.

**Application Process:** The Arrowhead Design Review Committee shall review applications for event tents at least 2 weeks prior to a proposed event in which a tent would be requested. Submittal is to include an application, a site plan depicting location of proposed tent, details of the proposed tent (size and color), and if the tent is proposed on property not owned by the requestor, written consent from the actual property owner is to be remitted. If the tent request conforms to the tent guidelines, approval by the Arrowhead Design Review staff may be granted.
