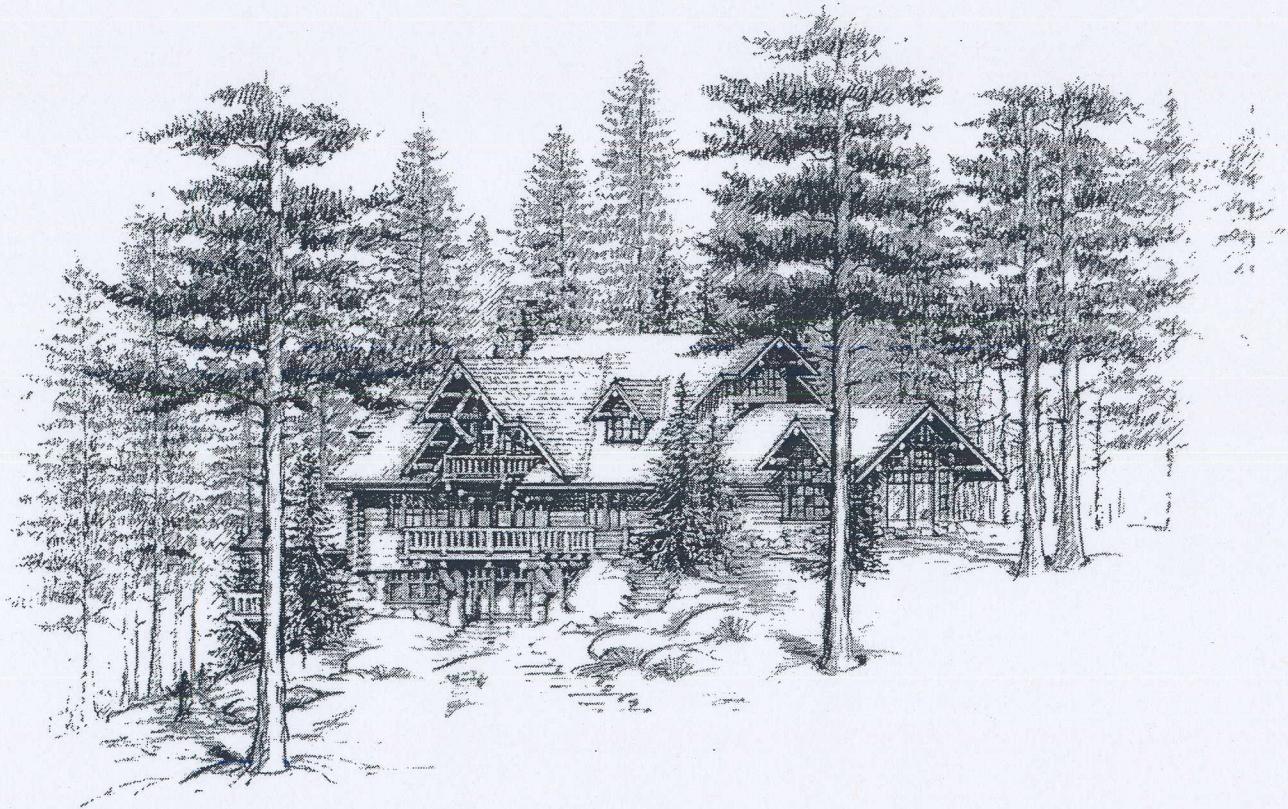


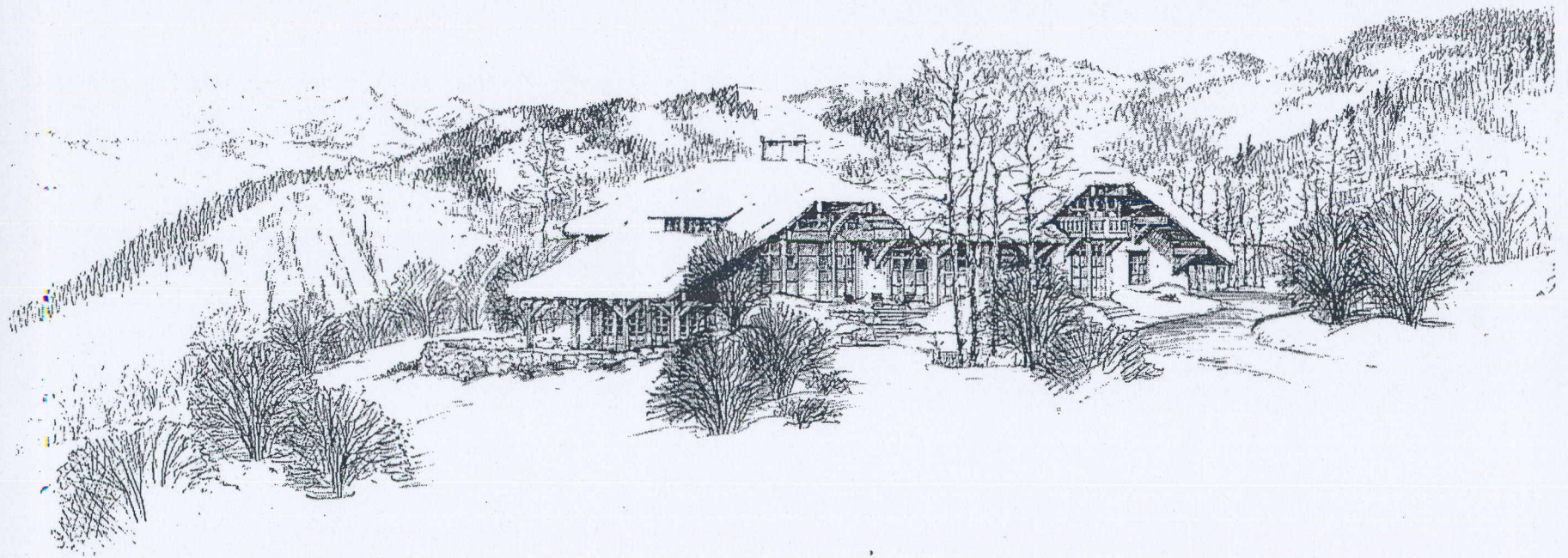
## APPENDIX G - ACCEPTABLE HOME DESIGNS

---

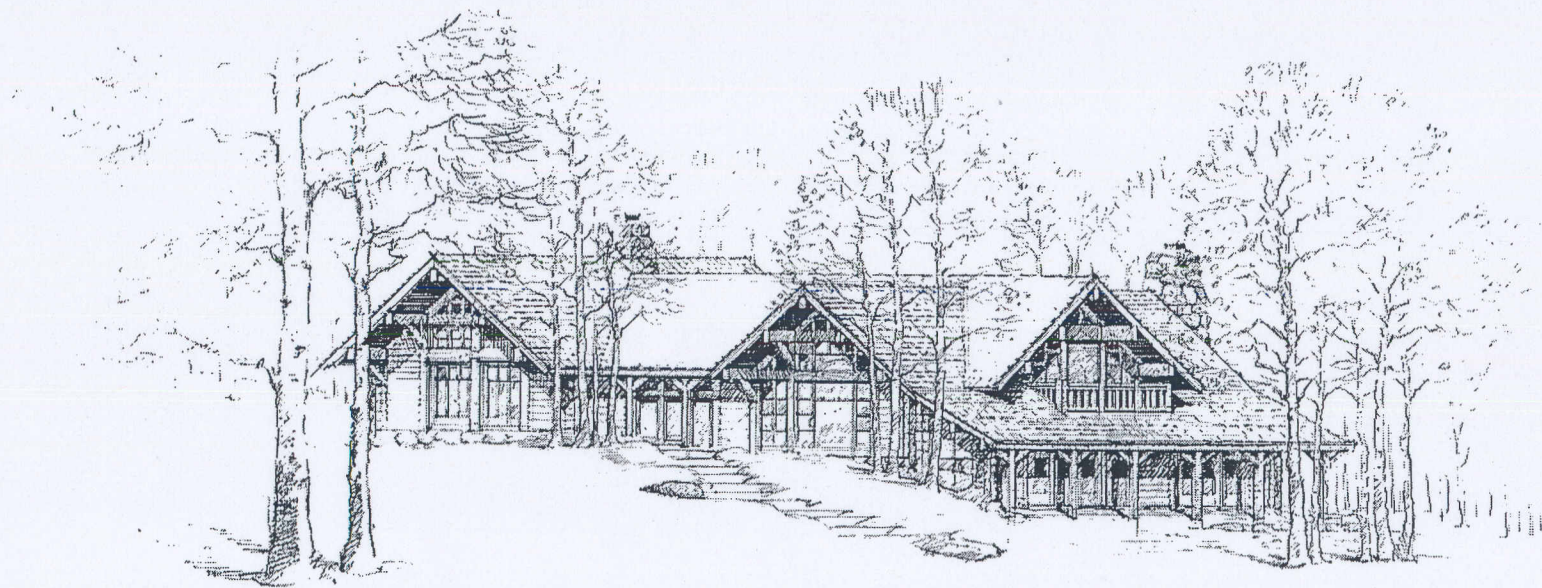
The following renderings are artist's concepts shown in black and white of acceptable interpretations of the guidelines. Color versions, showing acceptable color palettes, are available for review in the Bachelor Gulch Village Sales and Information Center.



A 6,000 - 10,000 square foot home shown in the "Conifer Zone" is built with logs on a stone foundation. It features large roof overhangs, shaded windows, balconies and access to the ski trails.



Built of stucco walls with timbers on stone foundations, this 6,000 - 8,000 square foot home is shown in the "Mountain Shrub Zone." This home also features shaded windows and wide, low profile roof lines to hold snow and blend with the site. (The building forms and materials also satisfy the requirements for the "Meadow Zone".



A 6,000 - 10,000 square foot home shown in the "Aspen Zone" is acceptable for all zones. The simple construction includes limited stone with timber, posts, beams and rafters. This home also features wood siding, simple roof forms and shaded windows.



A 8,000 - 10,000 square foot home, also shown in the "Conifer Zone" is built of timbers and wood siding on stone foundations. Downhill from the road, this home features two stories with walk-out basement, shaded windows, balconies and large roof overhangs.



Shown in the "Meadow Zone," this 6,000 - 8,000 square foot home is built of logs on stone foundations. Low-profile roof forms hold snow and blend with the surroundings. The siting of the home is near aspen groves, and new trees will be planted to further integrate the building site.



Shown in the "Aspen Zone," this 8,000 - 10,000 square foot home is built of logs on stone foundations with shaded windows and a wide sheltering roof. The home is located uphill from the road with driveway access from below.
